WHAT IS IFLM?

The Integrated Farm & Land Management (IFLM) method of carbon farming is set for release in 2026. It will allow land managers to implement different practices in a single project, reflecting how properties operate as connected landscapes.

Its modular design offers a framework to match business goals and land capability.

WHY LAND MANAGERS ARE PAYING ATTENTION

IFLM is designed to support whole-of-farm carbon projects across a range of operations, including mixed enterprises. It may allow you to:

- ✓ Include natural regrowth of trees and shrubs as part of a project
- ✓ Recognise soil, vegetation and land management outcomes together
- ✓ Manage multiple activities under a single project
- ✓ Be flexible as science, data and technology improve

IFLM aims to make carbon feel like land management - not a separate system.

WHAT'S EXPECTED

The method is expected to begin with a small number of core modules, including:

- Regeneration of trees and shrubs
- Planting of trees and shrubs
- Additional modules, including soil carbon, will likely be added.

Key elements including eligibility requirements, measurement approaches and module makeup will be confirmed.
